

Journey insurance

The CPSU offers limited income protection for union members without sick leave credits who are seriously injured on their journey to or from work.

This protection is automatic for CPSU members and does not apply to non-members.

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Financial advice

CPSU financial planning management providers Industry Fund Services, offer both personalised advice services on a full range of topics as well as referral management services where appropriate. Advice topics available to CPSU members include retirement planning including 54/11 and age retirement, transition to retirement, tax effective strategies, maximising super, redundancy, life and income protection insurance and debt elimination.


