CSIRO received final approval of the proposed CSIRO Enterprise Agreement 2016 - 2020 by the Australian Public Service Commissioner on Thursday 29 September.

This means we will move to a staff ballot where you will be asked to vote and determine whether the CSIRO Enterprise Agreement 2016 - 2020 (EA) will be approved by staff. The ballot period will commence on Monday 24th and run until 11:59pm on Monday 31st October 2016.

The ballot is an opportunity for each of our 5000+ team to be involved in deciding the outcome of the proposed EA and your conditions at CSIRO. Greater participation means a more accurate reflection of your views so please be heard and cast your vote.

We will send information about the access period and ballot soon. While these details are being finalised you can visit the following resources:
