Women in science careers scholarships

Women in Science Careers Scholarships support the professional development of women in science careers at CSIRO, the Australian Astronomical Observatory and the National Measurement Institute by providing vertical networking opportunities, shadowing senior role models and/or mentoring programs.

Scholarships are for an amount from \$1000 to a maximum of \$3000, and awarded based on merit.

Support for women in science

The Staff Association is committed to supporting women in CSIRO as part of the Women in Science network and through leadership on issues of equity, diversity and work-life balance. Women in CSIRO are significantly under-represented amongst the ranks of senior scientific staff. The lack of opportunities for networking, shadowing and mentoring has been identified as a major factor in the under-representation.

The Scholarship recognises the importance of supporting women in developing their science careers in CSIRO and in the Australian Astronomical Observatory and the National Measurement Institute.

Conditions

- Be financial members of the CSIRO Staff Association;
- Be undertaking an approved and verifiable work activity involving vertical networking, shadowing senior role models and/or mentoring; and
- Not have received a Women in Science Careers Scholarship on any previous occasion

Applications must be countersigned by a Staff Association workplace delegate or member prior to being submitted. The Staff Association Executive selects the winners each year.
